Recipe for the month

SIMPLE PUMPKIN SOUP



This pumpkin soup is a family favourite. Full of the flavour of roast pumpkin, it is perfect with a dollop of sour cream and a sprinkle of fresh chives alongside some crusty bread.

METHOD

1. Heat oil in a pan and fry all vegetables until golden.
 2. Add stock to the pan.
 3. Bring to the boil and simmer for 20 minutes until all vegetables are soft.
 4. Purée in a blender.
- Taste and season with salt and pepper accordingly

INGREDIENTS

- 1 pumpkin, peeled de-seeded and cubed
- 1 large potato, peeled and cubed
- 1 large carrot, peeled and roughly chopped
- 1 onion, diced
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 2 l vegetable/chicken stock
