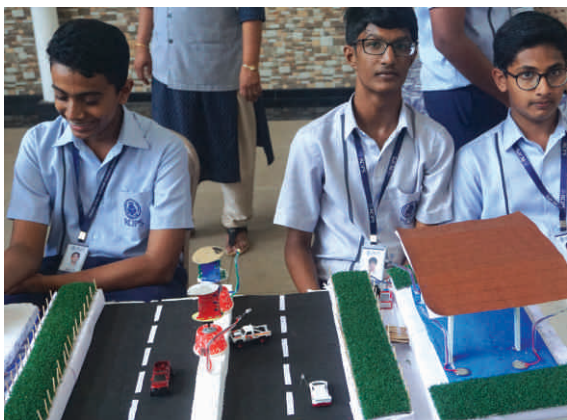


SPORTS DAY - JUNIOR & SENIOR
