PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING

1. NOTEBOOKS

Students of Grade II-VIII have to procure one notebook per subject for the time being from any nearby stationery store/supermarket. The list of notebooks / materials is attached in the annexure. Grade IX will get the books from school later and hence could use any notebooks for time being.

2. TEXTBOOKS

Owing to the current scenario, e-books maybe used which can be downloaded from the NCERT website <https://ncert.nic.in/textbook.php>. They can either be used as pdf files or printed chapter-wise, according to the convenience of the students. Once WhatsApp groups are formed class teachers will post the list of textbooks for each subjects. We will be following only NCERT textbooks. Malayalam textbooks will be given along with the workbooks from school.

The textbooks and record books are available at all H & C stores. The outlets also have the provision to door deliver the same if you wish to consider that option (Tele Booking No.: 9496334436). Post lockdown, books & materials can be directly procured from H & C stores. **Refer Annexure for details.**

3. WORKBOOKS/WORKSHEETS AND ASSIGNMENTS

We have prepared level appropriate worksheets for all subjects, which will be given from school. You can collect these on a later date (Dates will be informed). Tremendous effort has been put into the preparation of the same and I hope this will enhance learning and also make learning interesting for students.

4. COMMUNICATION

WhatsApp groups will be formed with all concerned including the subject teachers. Please feel free to utilise the same for any concerns/suggestions. Your feedback and suggestions are required to deliver the content effectively.

5. ONLINE CLASSES

We need to prepare children for regular classes soon hence please, do ensure that they develop the habit of sleeping early and waking up early enough.

- The platform used will be Microsoft Teams- Students are pretty familiar with the same by now.
- Timing & Schedule will be sent shortly.
- Students will be using the **MICROSOFT TEAMS ID & PASSWORD** given to them in the previous year.
- Please ensure that there is uninterrupted connectivity and that the video is turned on while attending classes.

6. UNIFORMS:

The purchase / stitching of new uniforms can wait till we are certain about students returning to school. Until then, students can attend the online classes in decent attire and stay well groomed. When the government announces re-opening of schools, you may get in touch with the vendors, according to your convenience. **Refer Annexure for details.**

7. ATTENDANCE

Attendance is marked on all working days. It is mandatory for students to attend the online classes. Microsoft Teams has the provision to note the login and log out time of a student making the teacher aware of the child's presence over the entire duration of the class.

Absence is permitted only on prior permission/intimation.

8. TIMETABLE & SCHEDULE

The timetable and schedule of each class will be sent across shortly. Students will receive the syllabus on a monthly basis, ahead of the start of the each month.

We did see a small ray of hope few months back and we believed we got the pandemic behind us, but it quickly disappeared and now here we are battling the deadly second wave and anticipating a third one. Amidst all these limitations and with over a year's experience in online delivery of classes we are far more competent to make the same as holistic as possible from our side. We are working on fresh initiatives and doing our best to strike a balance between scholastic and co-scholastic areas in order to ensure that our students are kept occupied and their education is holistic.


