
1. Another 10% deduction in all components in the school fees this academic year also (a 20% deduction including the last year's deduction).
2. Bus fees will not be collected until buses start plying.

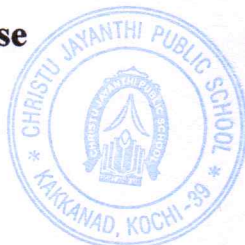
3. Annual fees also with a 10% deduction may be paid in four instalments.
4. Do login to the fee payment portal in our website for the updated fee structure with the present deductions from **THURSDAY, 10 JUNE 2021** onwards.
5. The dates for payment of first quarter fees will be from 10 JUNE to 30 JUNE 2021.
